Scouting for Food – October 3rd and October 10th

Scouting for Food is a **National Good Turn** of the Boy Scouts of America. Our Pack is proud to be a part of the 2009 Council-Wide Scouting for Food Initiative. The food is very much needed in many of our communities and now is the time of year where pantries aren't getting the support they need (unlike the holidays where many have food drives for the season). Delaware district is donating all collected items to Benefitting People in Need in Delaware.

How Scouting For Food Works?

October 2nd and 3rd, scouts will distribute bags to homes in their community with a note letting the family know that they will come by the following weekend to pick up the canned goods and deliver them to the Food Pantry. **October 10th**, scouts will collect the bags and take them to the designated drop off area.

We have split the pack into 2 groups to cover 2 large neighborhoods. Those living West of Rt. 23 will cover Highmeadows/Greenmeadows Subdivision. And those living East of Rt. 23, will cover Olentangy Meadows Subdivision and surrounding areas.

East Side: Oct 2nd @ 6pm bag pick up at OMES. Distribute to Olentangy Meadows and surrounding area. Pick up bags Oct 10th starting @9am and drop by 1pm.

West Side: Oct 3rd @ 9am bag pick up at 289 Highmeadows Village Dr. (Highmeadows residents), or 406 Highmeadows Village Dr. (Greenmeadows Residents). Pick up bags Oct 10th starting @9am and drop by 1pm.
